RE: Comprehensive Spending Review and Mental Health

I am writing on behalf of the Mental Health Foundation, of which I am a champion, and in relation to their letter to you on future government spending for mental health services.

Mental health support is a hugely important issue for my constituents in Carshalton and Wallington, and is something I have raised several times in the House since I became their MP, including in debates earlier in the year on the NHS Funding Bill.

COVID-19 has had a huge impact on the mental health of people across the country, and I am aware of research that has shown there will be around 10 million people with new or increased needs due to the pandemic.
